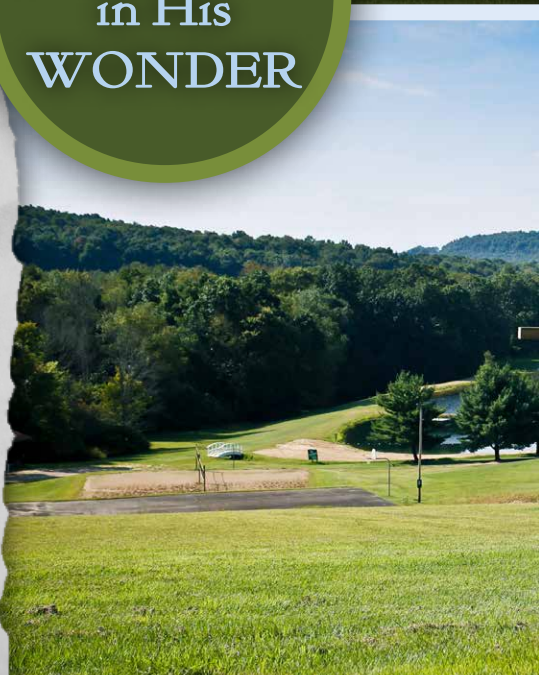


Main Speaker - Dave Overholt

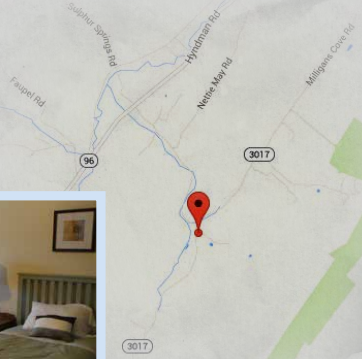
