# FREE AT LAST



We are excited to announce that our theme this Summer will be "Free at Last!". Our summer verses are Romans 8:1-5. Verses 1-2 say, "There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death." To appreciate true freedom we must first be aware of our captivity, specifically to sin! If we don't comprehend the severity of the charges against us, we cannot be grateful for our freedom.

In the context of Romans 8, to understand freedom is to understand condemnation. We often think of condemnation as the verdict we are given for our crimes. As sinners, we are all condemned to death for our sin against a holy God, but the word condemnation here

(katakrima) actually refers to the penalty itself. What Paul is saying is that we are free from not only being condemned of our sin, but the penalty that goes with it!

We were condemned, sentenced to an eternal death, but because of Christ's work on our behalf, we are free from that! The chains of our sin, that once bound us to hopelessness, are now dissolved! This is not only the amazing message of the Gospel, but it is the joy and hope that we are to live in daily.

Spring is a time when we fine tune the training in our horse herd to prepare them for the retreat and summer season ahead. Horses are motivated to obey by either reward or consequence. They certainly aren't driven to obedience by their gratefulness for all the things you do for them or provide for them like feeding them or cleaning out their stall. But as God's children, we should be motivated to obedience because of what Christ has done. Freedom in Christ, because of Christ, through Christ is a liberating gift, and we should live out each day in this knowledge. There are times when we get discouraged by our sin, but these moments should serve as a reminder that we should be walking in tremendous gratitude for our escape! And that, my friends, is a game changer! For those of us who have placed their faith and trust in the saving work of Jesus Christ, we are truly Free at Last!

### **BUILD A BUNKHOUSE CAMPAIGN**

We are looking forward to the future ministry God has for Miracle Mountain Ranch. Due to the lack of camps this past year, it is tempting to pull back and not build anything right now. But, God has not given us a spirit of fear! There are thousands of kids that will come for fun, adventure, and finding Christ at camp and we need to be ready. For that reason, we are pressing on to build a new bunkhouse. It is both a replacement and an upgrade. We will build this bunkhouse with two units each housing about 12 people. They will each have a double bathroom so that we can better accommodate ranchers. You have helped us raise about

\$65,000 on this project. We need \$75,000 to break ground and between \$125,000-\$175,000 to finish it. The flux in price depends on material costs and volunteers to build. We would love for a professional construction company to help build this project. The savings would be huge. Would you consider helping with this project? We need volunteers, sponsors and prayer partners to help us finish. We are ALSO working to renovate 4 other bunkhouses, so if your church or company would be interested we could use volunteers to help finish those projects as well.
