Not only has God blessed me with a job I can now confidently say that I love, but He has also blessed me by allowing me to become the nurse for the students this fall, now that Patty May has retired. I always prayed for a house full of kids, and now God has given me 31 students that I have the joy of taking care of in this way. It seems as if God feels I am best kept busy if I am going to stay out of trouble!

I suppose God felt that all of my responsibilities in the kitchen and as nurse were not quite enough to keep me humble, because He has also blessed me with an ever-growing little boy to keep up with! Christopher has just started kindergarten at our local Christian School, and he loves it! While he does not turn 5 until October, he was tested in at a very high level into his kindergarten class. Sometimes I feel that he is just a little bit too smart for his own good, but it keeps me on my toes!
