

Dear family and friends,

In April I have the opportunity to go on a 2-week mission trip to the Sierra Madre Mountains of Mexico. On this trip we will be going to a mission outpost in Rio Chico, spending some time working on construction and maintenance projects and ministering to the missionaries and people there. We will then head out on a 7+ hour drive into the Sierra Madre Mountains to a Pima Indian Village called Babicora in Chihuahua. In Babicora we will spend several days putting on day camps for the kids, inviting the women of the village to do some craft projects, working on projects for the pastor and church there, providing medical care, distributing food, clothing and shoes and sharing the Gospel every chance we get. The village of Babicora has a population of around 400 people. They have no electricity or running water. Only in the last 6 - 7 years have they had good, clean water year round as this trip has drilled quite a few wells for the village on the trips that they have taken.

I am looking forward to sharing Christ's love with the people in Mexico in every opportunity that God places before me. Even though there will be a language barrier, I know God will use me if I am willing.

We will leave for the trip from Miracle Mountain Ranch on April 2nd and will return on the 17th. The cost of this trip is \$1200. I would be so grateful if you could come alongside us in prayer. Prayers for safety on the trip, the bus and vehicles to run well, the people's hearts to be open to the Gospel and the growth of the Christians there.
