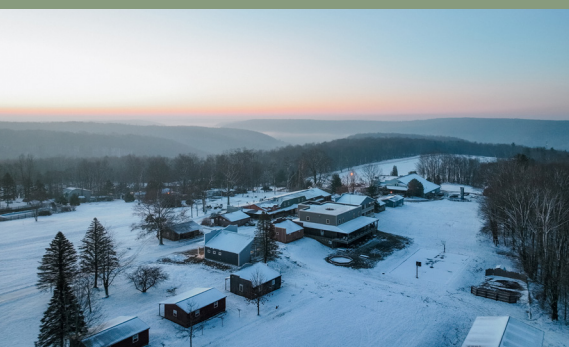


an update from
